THE CHALLENGE

The Medical University of South Carolina manages a wide range of pilot grant programs designed to support translational research.

These programs run multiple funding cycles throughout the year and involve collaboration across many departments. Managing these competitions manually or through separate systems made coordination difficult and time-consuming.

The institute needed a centralized platform to simplify program administration while allowing departments to run their own competitions.

THE SOLUTION

MUSC adopted InfoReady as the centralized application and review platform for its grant programs.

Now, multiple departments across campus use the platform to manage their own funding opportunities, including:

- Pilot grant programs
- Limited submission opportunities
- Workforce development grants
