## THE CHALLENGE

Virginia Tech's Office of Research and Innovation manages limited submission opportunities from major funding agencies.

The office previously relied on an internally developed platform that had become outdated and difficult to maintain.

The system was no longer intuitive for faculty and required significant administrative effort to manage.

## THE SOLUTION

Virginia Tech transitioned its limited submission process to InfoReady.
